Section 2 - The word "electronic" should be deleted from definition 2.1. Actuarial Communications may be written or oral. Either type (written or oral) can be in electronic or hard copy form. The word "electronic" in the proposed definition is superfluous and confusing. An alternative would be to add a second sentence to read as follows: "Actuarial Communications include those issued in electronic form."

Section 3 - The last sentence of Paragraph 3.1.4 should be changed to read as follows: "Unless the actuary includes a statement to the contrary, it is assumed that the responsible actuary will be available to provide supplementary information and explanation."
