Following 3.6.1 (d) where the reviewing actuary provides "a summary description of the results of the review, providing conclusions or findings"..... it seems to me that 3.6.2 should be expanded to have the responding actuary comment on the report received from the reviewing actuary.

What's the response? The responding actuary should comment on the reviewing actuary's report: a) agree with comment (and perhaps changing some reviewed item); b) agree with comment, but not changing reviewed item; c) disagree with comment and not making any change, etc.

In other words, if the reviewing actuary produces a report, I think the standard should suggest that responding actuary comment on the report received.
